THE OWNERSHIP/MANAGEMENT ISSUE THAT ORIGINALLY WAS THE REASON FOR THE REQUEST FOR STA TO SILENCE KYRN WILL GO TO TRIAL IN DECEMBER. HOWEVER, THE LICENSEE COULD GO BACK ON THE AIR DUE TO CHANGES IN THE CENTRAL STUDIO RULE AND WOULD DO SO, BUT THE OTHER PARTY IN THE CASE HAS TAKEN THE STATION'S PRIMARY TRANSMITTING EQUIPMENT AND HAS NOT RETURNED IT DESPITE BEING ORDERED TO DO SO BY THE COURTS. THEREFORE IT IS LIKELY THAT IT WILL BE IMPOSSIBLE TO RETURN THE STATION TO THE AIR UNTIL AFTER THE TRIAL ENDS IN MID-DECEMBER. WITH THAT IN MIND IT IS REQUESTED THAT STA FOR SILENCE BE EXTENDED UNTIL FEBRUARY 1, 2019.
